- Promote
 - GGOS goals
- Advocate
 - Improved access to data
 - Space-based, ground-based
 - Freely available without delay
 - Continuous uninterrupted supply
- Facilitate
 - Communication and coordination
 - Interagency, intergovernmental

GGOS Stakeholders Conference: the View from the Sciences 2/2

Operational science

Entities for which channels are already established in order to feed the benefits of geodesy back to society

- Obvious GEO, WMO (as representing all national weather services), oceans ICO
- Not so obvious
 - UN organizations that regulate transportation: ICAO (air) and equivalent for sea
 - International transportation syndicates: IATA (airlines), maritime
 - Famous instrument manufacturers (e.g. Vaisala, space instrument leaders, GPS rec.)
- Insist on the fact that geodesy products (from GGOS) are the foundations of current & future developments that allow to increasingly benefit from GNSS pos.

Research science

Entities for which geodesy products are essential to carry out research

- Obvious: space agencies, selected member societies of AIP, AGU, EGU, AMS cannot convene individual research institutes (otherwise, which ones?).
- Outreach: WWF
- Insist on the need for GGOS to have a free access to NRT data
